

HOW TO REGISTER FOR OHLONE: A GUIDE BY JERRY

NOTE: YOU NEED TO PRINT SOMETHING, MAKE SURE YOU HAVE \$0.10

1. Yo, go to <http://www.ohlone.edu/go/applyonline> and it'll redirect you to a really cool site called "CCCApply."
2. Most of you don't have an account or don't remember it, it's best to click **CREATE AN ACCOUNT**.
3. It'll redirect you to a new site. Click the button at the bottom of the page that says **BEGIN CREATING MY ACCOUNT**. It's blue.
 - a. **Enter your first and last name, and your middle name** (if you don't have one, like me, click the box right under it that says "Check this box if you do not have a middle name." And your suffix, if you have one. And your maiden name, if you got married??? If not, click "No.")
 - b. **Enter your date of birth**. Happy early birthday!
 - c. Uncheck the button that says "**I plan to apply for admission to college or financial aid.**"
 - d. **DO NOT. DO NOT PUT YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. DO NOT.** There's a small little box at the bottom of the page that says "**Check this box if you do not have a Social Security Number or Taxpayer Identification Number, or decline to provide one at this time.**" Please check that box. They do scary things if you give it to them. Click the "Continue" button. It's blue.
 - e. **Enter your email**. Enter it again.
 - f. **Enter your telephone number** in this format "481-516-3424." **Do not authorize text messages**. I warn you.
 - g. **Enter street address blah blah**. Click the "Continue" button. It's blue.
 - h. **Create a username! And password!** Remember it, if you want to.
 - i. **Enter a pin!** Enter it again! **Security questions!**
 - j. **Do the weird CAPTCHA thing**. If you get it wrong, you'll have to type out your password and pin again. I speak from experience. Click the "Continue" button. It's blue.
4. Click the "**Start A New Application**" button." Guess what, it's blue. AND TURNS GREEN ONCE YOU HOVER OVER it.
5. Click "**Start Application**" once you've read everything over.
 - a. ENROLLMENT INFORMATION
 - i. Term Applying for is "**Spring 2015 (01/26/2015 to 05/22/2015).**"
 - ii. Intended Major or Program of Study is "**Transfer: Other.**"
 - iii. Educational Goal is "**Undecided on Goal.**" Click "Continue."
 - b. ACCOUNT/MAILING INFORMATION
 - i. Look over and see if your address and stuff is correct.
 - ii. Click "**My mailing address is the same as the Permanent Address in my OpenCCC Account above**" if everything is cool. Click "Continue."
 - c. PERSONAL INFORMATION

- i. **Select your gender.** If you don't identify as male or female, or don't want to state, that's cool too. Click "**Decline to state.**"
 - ii. They're going to ask you about your parents/guardian(s) If any of the first 5 statements are true, click that option. If not, click "**None of the statements above is true about me.**"
 - iii. Provide **the first and last name of your parent/guardian (and relationship).** Then select their educational levels. If you don't know, there's an "Unknown" option!
 - iv. Aaand if you're Hispanic/Latino, you can specify. If not, **select your race.** Apparently, they're required to collect this kind of data. Click "Continue."
- d. EDUCATION
- i. As of 01/25/2015, I will have the following college enrollment status is "**Enrolling in high school (or lower grade) and college at the same time.**"
 - ii. High school education level is "**Will be enrolled in high school (or lower grade) and college at the same time.**" And **enter your high school completion date.** I wish I could tell you when you graduate but truth is I don't know when I graduate either so I just put a random date.
 - iii. "Have you attended high school in California for three or more years?" If that statement is true, **check "Yes."** If not, **check "No."**
 - iv. Check "**I attended high school.**" And **select the country (United States) and the state (California).**
 - v. Where it says enter the name of your high school blah, **enter "Lowell High, San Francisco" and click it on the dropdown menu.** I swear I tried typing in Lowell High School, but, believe me, that does not work. Remember, they're here just to confuse us.
 - vi. College education level as of 01/25/2015 is "**No degree.**" Unless you have a degree...which would be weird.
 - vii. Specify the number of colleges you have attended including those you are currently attending is "**None.**" Unless you have gone to college...which would be weird. Click "Continue."
- e. CITIZENSHIP/MILITARY
- i. For Citizenship Status, select "**U.S. Citizen.**" Unless you're not. Then you should tell me.
 - ii. If you've served in the military select your thing from the dropdown menu. If not, click "**None apply to me.**" Click "Continue."
- f. RESIDENCY
- i. "Has your parent or guardian lived in California continuously since 01/25/2013?" If that's true, click "**Yes.**" If not, do the info stuff.
 - ii. If your parent/guardian is a full-time employee at one of the four colleges click "**Yes.**" If not, click "**No.**"
 - iii. If you're credentialed and stuff click "**Yes.**" If not, click "**No.**"
 - iv. If your parent/guardian is employed as a seasonal agricultural worker for at least two months in the past two years, click "**Yes.**" If not, click "**No.**"

- v. If you've ever been in Foster Care click "Yes." If not, click "**No.**"
 - vi. I'm too lazy to type out the rest, if it applies to you click "Yes" and provide the stuff if they ask for the stuff. If not, "**No.**" Click "Continue."
- g. **NEEDS AND INTERESTS**
- i. If you're comfortable reading/writing in English click "**Yes.**"
 - ii. If you're interested in receiving financial advice click "Yes." I think it's pretty much spam so click "**No**" if you're not interested.
 - iii. If the other thing applies to you click "Yes." If not, click "**No.**"
 - iv. If you do the sport thing you can click "Yes" I guess. It says your response does not obligate you in any way so congrats. If not, unfortunately we still have to take P.E. classes, click "**No.**"
 - v. **Don't click any of the Programs & Services.** There might be consequences if you do. Click "Continue."
- h. **SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONS (EVEN THOUGH THERE IS ONLY 1 QUESTION)**
- i. If you're deaf/hard of hearing check the box. You actually don't even have to answer it if you are. **It's optional.** Click "Continue."
- i. **CONSENT (CONSENT IS ALWAYS IMPORTANT)**
- i. Pretend to read the Privacy Policy. Check "**I Consent**" or the other option. It doesn't matter. Click "Continue."
- j. **REVIEW APPLICATION**
- i. Pretend to look over everything. If you're satisfied with yourself click "**I have reviewed this application and confirm it is complete and accurate.**" It'll turn green! **YOU ARE NOT DONE YET. I SWEAR IF YOU THINK YOU'RE DONE YOU ARE WRONG.**
- k. I AM PUTTING THIS IN ALL CAPS BECAUSE IF YOU CLICK THAT "FINISH" BUTTON I WILL BE SO ANGRY.
- I. FINAL STEP: CONFIRMATION**
- i. DO NOT CLICK "FINISH," Luke Howard. What you do now is **EITHER PRESS:**
 1. "**CTRL+P**"
 2. "**THE WEIRD APPLE THING+P:**
 3. **OR GO TO "FILE>PRINT" BECAUSE YOU NEED TO PRINT THIS CONFIRMATION PAGE.**
 4. The confirmation thing is 2 pages. Remove the margins and make it portrait view. That should work to get it down to a page, maybe. If not, 2 pages is fine. Be sure to staple them. Click "Finish." And click "Sign Out."
